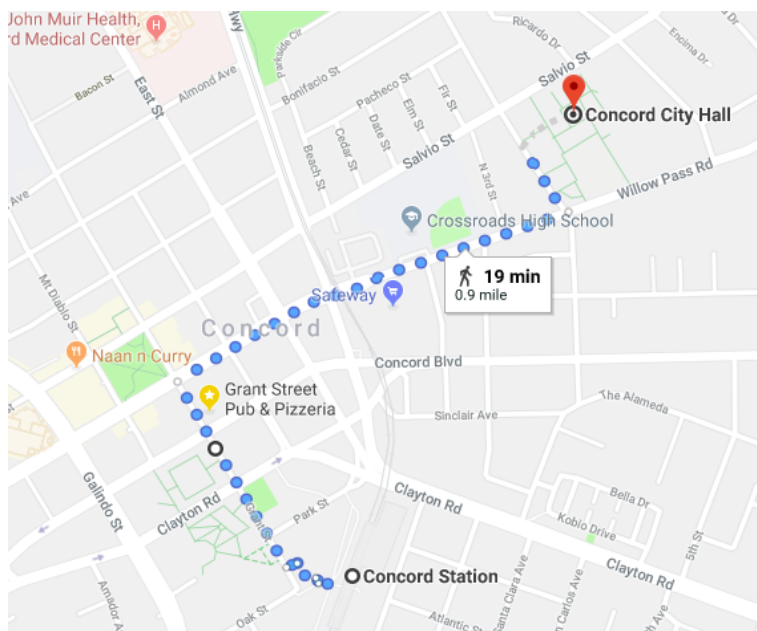
Concord is for all. Protect human rights and abolish ICE.

Concord against Concentration is a coalition of organizations and individuals from Concord, Diablo, Walnut Creek, the East Bay and beyond. We have organized to urge the City of Concord do everything in their power to prevent the US Naval Weapons Station from becoming an ICE concentration camp, and to demand that the Federal government abolish ICE, close immigrant detention camps, and reunite separated families. While Concord City Council has scheduled a Special Meeting on this for June 27th at 1pm, our action tonight is still happening and is in support of their actions to oppose this camp. We stand with solidarity in opposition to the human rights abuses carried out by ICE, and make these demands:

- Abolish ICE and invest ICE's budget in communities who have been terrorized by ICE - Especially in black, brown, and indigenous communities.
- Free all immigrant detainees and close all immigrant detention centers
- Reunite families separated by ICE

At 5:00PM today we will be assembling at Concord BART station and marching to City Hall, followed by our rally around 5:30pm in advance of the 6:00 pm city council meeting. At the Concord City Council meeting we will be voicing our support for the City of Concord to utilize every means available to them to stop this concentration camp. Public comment for tonight is extremely time limited; please allow Concord residents and workers to speak first, then those of neighboring towns of Contra Costa, and finally allies from other parts of the Bay Area.
